OCASSE November Technical Meeting – November 18th *Kill the Staph, Not Your Staff!*

Protecting the people who eat the food (Food Safety) as well as protecting the people who make the food (Employee Safety) can sometimes feel like opposing sciences.

Do eye wash stations interfere with handwash sinks? Does a shiny smooth cleanable floor create a slip hazard?

Do anti-slip floor mats impede kitchen clean-up? Does the use of Virucidal sanitizers potentially over-expose kitchen workers? Does a cut resistant glove contribute to bacterial cross contamination?
